

The 7 Spiritual Days of Creation in Genesis the first book of the Holy Bible that takes a person from Darkness (lack of knowledge of the New Jerusalem Kingdom of God and Jesus Christ on Earth) to Light (knowledge of the New Jerusalem Kingdom of God and Jesus Christ on Earth)

The First Day:

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. 2 and the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. 3 And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. 4 And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness. 5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

Okay so let's start with the face of the deep waters that the Spirit of God moved on. The deep waters spiritually represent the entire knowledge of everything. It goes pretty deep. There was darkness which means the revelation of the truth of God did not happened yet, so God said, Let there be light and the light spiritually represents the truth of God. The Night represents spiritual darkness or lack of knowledge of the truth of God. So a spiritual day represents coming out of darkness and into the light (coming from lack of knowledge into the truth). That's what the first spiritual day of creation is about.

The Second Day:

Genesis 1:6 And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters. 7 And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so. 8 And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and morning were the second day.

So on the second day you go from the spiritual darkness of not knowing that Heaven exists to the spiritual light that Heaven exists. Heaven is the spiritual knowledge of God that divides the spiritual waters (truths) about things.

The Third Day:

Genesis 1:9 And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so. 10 And God called the dry land Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that it was good. 11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so. 12 And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and God saw that it was good. 13 And the evening and the morning were the third day.

Okay so on the third spiritual day God shows us the form of the spiritual earth. Earth is the center for the different spiritual knowledge centers (Seas). The Seas represent the different religions. The spiritual grass, herbs and fruit of each religion is for the spiritual feeding of each kind.

The Fourth Day:

Genesis 1:14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night: and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years.15 And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so. 16 And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night; he made the stars also. 17 And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth, 18 And to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness: and God saw that it was good. 19 And the evening and the morning were the fourth day.

On the fourth spiritual day, God made Jesus Christ (the greater light) to rule over the truth light of the Day (Christianity) and Satan (the lesser light) to rule over the spiritual darkness of the Night (false religions). The stars spiritually represent other spirits of light like Abraham, Moses, King David, the 12 disciples,

Esther and other spirits of the light of God that you see when you read the Holy Bible. Also the New Jerusalem Calendar was created for the signs, seasons, days, and years.

So on the fourth spiritual day it gives more details of how the light and darkness are divided. Jesus is the Light, Satan and false religions are in the darkness. As we progress you will see the story of how it all happened.

The Fifth Day:

Genesis 1:20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven. 21 and God created great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good. 22 And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let fowl multiply in the earth. 23 And the evening and the morning were the fifth day.

So the fifth day represents becoming a spiritual living being that has eaten the spiritual grass, herbs and fruit of God's truth system and can fly or swim in the spiritual air and waters. Meaning a spirit being that has a lot of knowledge of truth and can teach about it. For instance, Jesus is a spiritual whale in the spiritual Sea and the 12 disciples can be thought of as spiritual fowls flying in the spiritual air. So the fifth day spiritually represents becoming an awakened spiritual being that can be spiritually fruitful and multiply.

The Sixth Day:

Genesis 1:24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so. 25 And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that it was good. 26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have

dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. 27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. 28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth. 29 And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat. 30 And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein there is life, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so. 31 And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

The spiritual sixth day shows how there are many spiritual belief systems in the earth and represents the creation of an awakened spiritual being of God having dominion over all of the different religions on earth because of the light of Jesus Christ leading to the knowledge of truth from God the Father.

The Seventh Day:

Genesis 2:1 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. 2 And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

So the spiritual seventh day represents coming out of spiritual darkness into the spiritual light of the New Jerusalem Kingdom of God and Jesus Christ on Earth where your mind can be at rest with the knowledge of the truth. From this point in the Holy Bible, after the 7 spiritual days of creation in Genesis, the Bible takes you on a journey to the New Jerusalem Kingdom of God and Jesus Christ on Earth at the end of the Bible. When you read about the days of creation in Genesis, you need to think about the spiritual meanings of the words.
