Jesus came to Jerusalem on Palm Tuesday, March 10, as the Passover Lamb. On Passover Saturday night, March 14, Jesus had the Last Supper with his disciples into Sunday the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, March 15, then was taken away early Sunday morning to be on trial during the week up until Good Friday, March 20, when the people crucified him. Jesus was in the tomb on Saturday the high holy day Sabbath seventh day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, March 21, and then rose again on Easter Sunday, March 22, being seen 40 days to Ascension Day Thursday, April 31, and then 10 days later was Pentecost Sunday, May 10, and the birth of the Church.
